

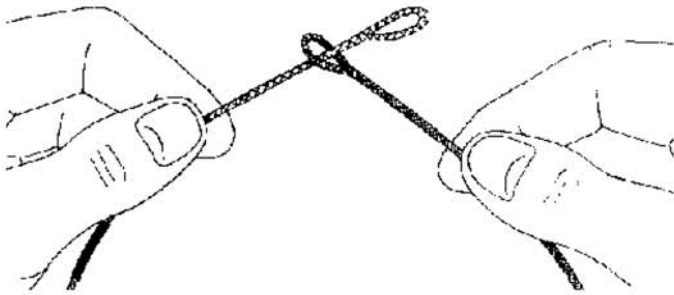

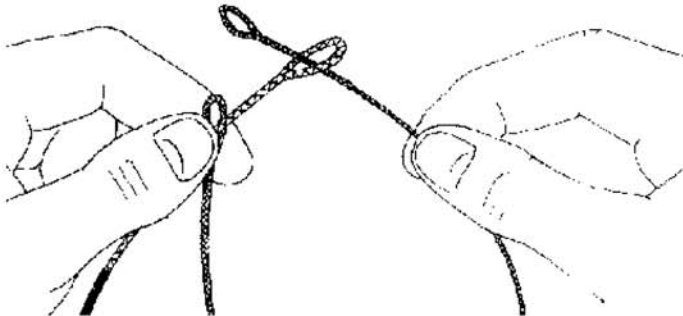

Loop to Loop

Use to connect braided leader butt to fly line with either permanent monofilament loop or braided loop connector; or to connect smaller end of braided leader butt to monofilament leader tippet with the loop in butt end.



Step One: Pass the end of the fly line loop through the larger end of the leader butt loop.



Step Two: Then pass the small end of the leader butt section through the fly line loop.



Step Three: Tighten by pulling in opposite directions. You can disconnect the loops by pushing them toward each other and reversing the process. The correct loop-to-loop connection looks like a square knot when complete.



Step Four: As an example this is an Incorrect loop-to-loop connection. Attaching the loops this way weakens the connection considerably.
